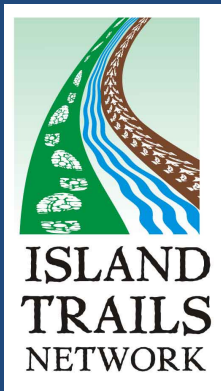


## Did You Know
