Public Notice

ADL 232680: Existing Road, Saltery Cove Road, in Kodiak, AK  
Applicant: Kodiak Island Borough

Pursuant to Alaska Statute 38.05.850, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Division of Mining, Land, and Water (DMLW), Southcentral Region Office is considering a request from Kodiak Island Borough to create a public access easement to authorize an existing road, Saltery Cove Road, to provide access to Saltery Cove, Portage Bay and connect with Lake Miam Trails. If approved, the easement will be held by DNR DMLW on behalf of the public. The existing road is located on State-owned, DMLW-managed lands within:

- Sections 16, 17, 21 20, 29, 32, and 31 of Township 30 South, Range 21 West, Seward Meridian
- Sections 6 and 7 of Township 31 South, Range 21 West, Seward Meridian
- Section 12 of Township 31 South, Range 22 West, Seward Meridian

The proposed easement is approximately 190,882 feet in length, 100 feet wide and occupies approximately 438 acres of State land. While no construction is planned as the road is already in place, portions of the road may undergo trail hardening. The proposed easement is highlighted in red and shown in the attached image.

Members of the public and interested parties are invited to comment on this project. **DMLW must receive written comments no later than 5:00 pm November 7, 2016.** In order to be given full consideration, all comments should clearly explain the facts on which they are based and how they pertain to the proposed easement.
